Matrix Numerical Column Explanation

1 STUDENT's Reading Level

H = Reading at or above grade level
M = Reading below grade level
L = Reading significantly below grade level

2 TEAM's Social Emotional Supports

H = Team possesses supports for students who require multiple redirections
M = Team possesses varying supports for students SEL development
L = Team possesses limited SEL student supports

3 TEAM's Career Connectedness

H = Team possesses vocational requirements/Work Keys
M = Career Plans are developed/Option for work credit available
L = Limited time available for career instruction

4 STUDENT's Connectedness to Home School

H = Likely to return to home school
M = May take some classes at home school/homeschool checks on progress
L = Competency completion within team expected

5 TEAM's level of Student Service Supports

H = Student Service support readily available
M = Student Service support available on a weekly rotation
L = Student Service support as needed

6 STUDENT's Travel Expectations

H = Student expected to make multiple transportation transitions
M = Student able to get to team
L = Logistical obstacles

7 STUDENT's Commitment to Team

H = Student's desire to enroll is intense
M = Student is willing to interview
L = Someone else is suggesting enrollment
